


# **NON HUNTING ACTIVITIES**

#### **BIG ADVENTURE**


Feel the adrenaline on this amazing adventure by going on a boat ride and be the closest you can get to the Falls. Feeling the steam and listening to the roar of the waterfalls is just a part of everything that the waterfalls will make you experience.





### **VISIT THE BRAZILIAN SIDE OF THE FALLS**

The Brazilian side offers an amazing perspective. The spectacular panoramic views of Iguazú Falls make it the perfect place to take photographs and get a sense of its scope and scale.





# VISIT THE ARGENTINIAN SIDE OF THE FALLS

With around two-thirds of the waterfalls located in the country, there're plenty of opportunities to get intimate with the falls and get soaked in the process. Most people head straight to the main attraction, that being the Devil's Throat ("Garganta del Diablo" in Spanish).

In the Argentinian side you will see and feel the falls really close in an inexplicable way.











#### LANDMARK OF THE THREE FRONTIERS

It is a tourist attraction located a few blocks from downtown Puerto Iguazu, Argentina. The landmark is at the confluence of the Iguazu and Parana rivers. From the Argentinean coast, you can see the Brazilian and Paraguayan coasts. There are three similar obelisks at each border, each painted with the national colors of each country.

There is also a Craft Fair where you can buy handcrafts of the province of Misiones and you can see the Tancredo Neves Bridge connecting the cities of Puerto Iguazu (Argentina) and neighboring Brazil's Foz do Iguacu.











#### **GUIRA OGA**

To catch a glimpse of even more wildlife than the one you can see in the national park, head to this animal refuge where you'll find tons of birds; from toucans and parrots to eagles and owls. They've also got a few Capuchin monkeys, anteaters, capybaras, and other native mammals inside.

It's not a zoo, it's an animal rescue center so most of the birds here were brought to be rehabilitated after being wounded.






#### **BIRDING**

If you are interested, there are also many bird-watching activities in Iguazu and in the jungle. The area of the Iguazu Falls and surrounding Parks & Reserves offers important bird diversity.

The main characteristics that generate this exuberant Nature are its warm climate, constant humidity and the lack of dry seasons and changing climate. Here you can see about 250 species and it's a great destination for bird-watchers. Among the species you can find there is the Green Hea

ded Tanager, Toco Toucan, Black-fronted piping guan, Swallow-tailed Hummingbird and many many more!



A well-known Italian restaurant where clients always enjoy its homemade food. Delight yourself with one of the best fruit cakes and an incredible petit gâteau with great company.


















# **QUITA PENAS RESTO BAR / Puerto Iguazú**









### **SWIMWEAR**








### **SUN PROTECTION**

Protect yourself from the strong sun rays in Puerto Iguazu by packing sunscreen with a high SPF, sunglasses, and a wide-brimmed hat. Consider bringing a lightweight long-sleeved shirt or a lightweight scarf to cover your arms and shoulders.




### **CAMERA AND WATERPROOF PROTECTION**


### **PERSONAL ESSENTIALS**
